

IMPORTANT REMINDER

Deadline for Submitting Import or Export Declarations with 2006 UDR Numbers

We would like to notify you that with effect from 2007, ValuNet Deluxe has automatically reset the prefix of Unique Declaration Reference (UDR) number. The use of the UDR number is to define the year that the trade declarations are made. For example, the UDR number for Import or Export Declarations in 2006 is "Bxxxxxxxxxxxxx" or "6Axxxxxxxxxxxxx". All new Import or Export Declarations created on or after 1 January 2007 will be assigned with the new 2007 UDR numbers of "7Axxxxxxxxxxxxx".

For any Import or Export Declarations using 2006 UDR numbers that had been prepared but not yet submitted successfully in 2006, they must be resubmitted on or before 31 January 2007. If you submit Import or Export Declarations using 2006 UDR numbers after 31 January 2007, these declarations will be rejected (except Declaration Amendment). You will be required to resubmit these declarations with the new 2007 UDR numbers.

The Hong Kong Imports and Exports Classification List (Harmonised System) amendments for 2007 have taken effect from 1 January 2007. You are reminded to perform the Harmonised System upgrade* immediately to avoid any possible rejection. Simply download the upgrade patch by selecting:

"Start → Programs / All Programs → ValuNet Deluxe → Smart Upgrade"

(Note: Please be reminded to close all workstations before running the upgrade process.)
