Changes of Commodity Types in Electronic Cargo Manifest (“EMAN”)

As required by the Government, there are changes to the Commodity Types that are required to cope with the recent approval of the legislative amendments on certain dutiable commodities to be declared in Electronic Cargo Manifest (“EMAN”). These changes would take effect from 16 June 2008. Please find the details of the changes as follows:

Introduction of New Types	(1) Euro V Diesel (2) Other Liquors > 30% alcoholic strength	Not Applicable
Updated Descriptions	(1) Liqueur > 30% alcoholic strength (2) Ethyl Alcohol (pure) >30% alcoholic strength (3) Ethyl Alcohol (mixture) >30% alcoholic strength	(1) Liqueur (2) Ethyl Alcohol (pure) (3) Ethyl Alcohol (mixture)
Deletion of Existing Commodity Type	Not Applicable	(1) Champagne/Sparkling Wine (2) Port / Sherry (3) Other Wines (4) Beer (5) Stout

Tradelink will deliver a “Smart Upgrade Directive” to the LogiNet Standard software of our EMAN users. Upon receipt of the upgrade directive, if the first time users logon the LogiNet software on or after 16 June 2008, they are required to log-off the software and then logon again so as to effect the upgrade. Customers using import flat file for EMAN submissions can update the code settings of their own system accordingly as necessary.
