To: All CO Customers

Apply electronically for CO (CEPA) using Tradelink

The Trade and Industry Department announced in the Certificate of Origin Circular No. 23/2003 that the Mainland will apply zero import tariff from 1 January 2004 for goods in 273 Mainland 2001 tariff codes originating in Hong Kong. Traders can apply for a Certificate of Hong Kong Origin - CEPA ("CO(CEPA)") for each consignment of goods covered in the initial phase of tariff preference under CEPA with effect from 15 December 2003.

Please be informed that all applications for CO (CEPA) should be submitted via Tradelink electronic services. In lodging a CO(CEPA) application electronically, traders should provide all required details accurately and comply with additional Declarations Codes and data.

Customers to apply for CO (CEPA) electronically will require the Code Table Upgrade of ValuNet Standard on Internet or SilkNet Standard on Internet, which Tradelink will provide free of charge.

To receive the Code Table Upgrade, you are kindly requested to complete the "Reply Slip" enclosed with this Newsfax and return to us by fax to **2506 0388**. Once your Reply Slip is received, we will contact you again and arrange to deliver the Upgrade to your company at your convenience.
