

InterCommerce Network Services of Philippines admitted as the 10th full member of the PAA

(23 April 2010, Hong Kong) Tradelink Electronic Commerce Limited ("Tradelink", SEHK: 0536) announced that the Pan Asian e-Commerce Alliance (PAA) held its 34th Steering Committee meeting from 22nd to 23rd April 2010 in Cebu, The Philippines.

At the meeting, the Steering Committee admitted InterCommerce Network Services (INS) as a full member of the PAA. INS had been an Associate member of PAA since February 2008. PAA Chairman, Mr Leong Peng Kiong said "InterCommerce Network Services has been actively participating in the PAA initiatives, and enabled the extension of PAA services to the Philippines trading community. The Guest of Honour, Mr Alexander Arevalo, Deputy Commissioner of Philippines Bureau of Customs provided an update of the ASEAN Single Window initiative as well as the overview of the Philippines National Single Window project. He highlighted the possible role of PAA in connecting the ASEAN members, and the role of InterCommerce to provide automated solution to other government agencies in the Philippines.

The 35th PAA Meeting will be hosted by China International Electronic Commerce Center in China in August 2010.
